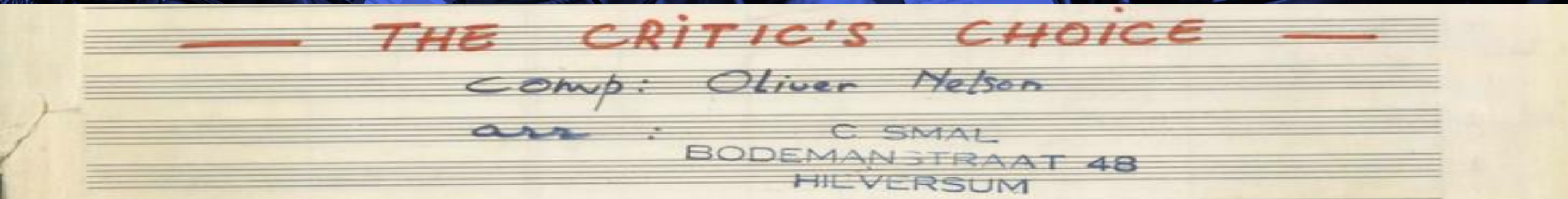

UITVOERINGSMEDIUM



- Six languages (**Dutch**, English, French, German, Italian, Spanish)
- Broader term for each vocabulary term (except for TopConcepts)
- Terms in singular form for individual instruments or voices
- Terms in plural form for homogenous ensembles (= one type of instrument or voice)
Specify size (e.g. *Quintet* / <https://data.muziekschatten.nl/som/um1633>)
- Instruments in heterogenous ensembles represented by family name
(e.g. *Ensemble of woodwind, brass, string, percussion* / <https://data.muziekschatten.nl/som/um912>)
- Distinguish between accompanied (*with accompaniment*) and unaccompanied vocal pieces
Specify instrumental accompaniment of a vocal piece (e.g. *Basso continuo* / <https://data.muziekschatten.nl/som/um278>)
- Separate term for each solo instrument with each orchestral accompaniment
(e.g. *Clarinet with wind band* / <https://data.muziekschatten.nl/som/um1513>)
- Pieces for a melody instrument and keyboard accompaniment are considered a heterogenous ensemble
(e.g. *Ensemble of woodwind and keyboard instrument* / <https://data.muziekschatten.nl/som/um897>)
- Includes identifier links from various relevant lists of terms (MIMO, Dewey DC, Wikidata, MusicBrainz en Arts & Architecture)

Explanatory notes:

- Composite terms are available for orchestral music (more instruments per part) with one or more solo instruments (e.g. *oboe with symphony orchestra* or *solo instruments with big band*)
- In instrumental ensemble music (one instrument per part), a solo instrument is considered one of the instruments within the performing ensemble. Specific terms are available for standard settings: e.g. *string quartet* or *piano trio*.
- In instrumental ensemble music with heterogeneous instrumentation, the instruments are classified in the family to which they belong (e.g. *ensemble of woodwind, brass, strings*).

Rather rich and of fairly good quality

(thanks to ISBD-cataloguing rules and use of controlled vocabularies:
IFLA Names of Persons, LoC: countries and language, Dewey DC)

Several vocabularies available in LOD-format

(persons, languages, countries , medium of performance)

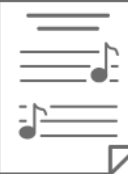

Entities model:

Musical Performance

Three case studies:

1. *Sesjun* (Muziekschatten/Nederlands Jazz Archief):

A jazz radio program series with live performances, used to explore modelling of broadcasted music events.

2. *Architecture of the Invisible* (Allard Pierson):

A dance program with multiple choreographic works, including a world premiere.

3. *Kijk in mijn ogen* (Nederlandse Dansdagen):

A site-specific music theatre piece, showing how performances recur across festivals.

Modelling

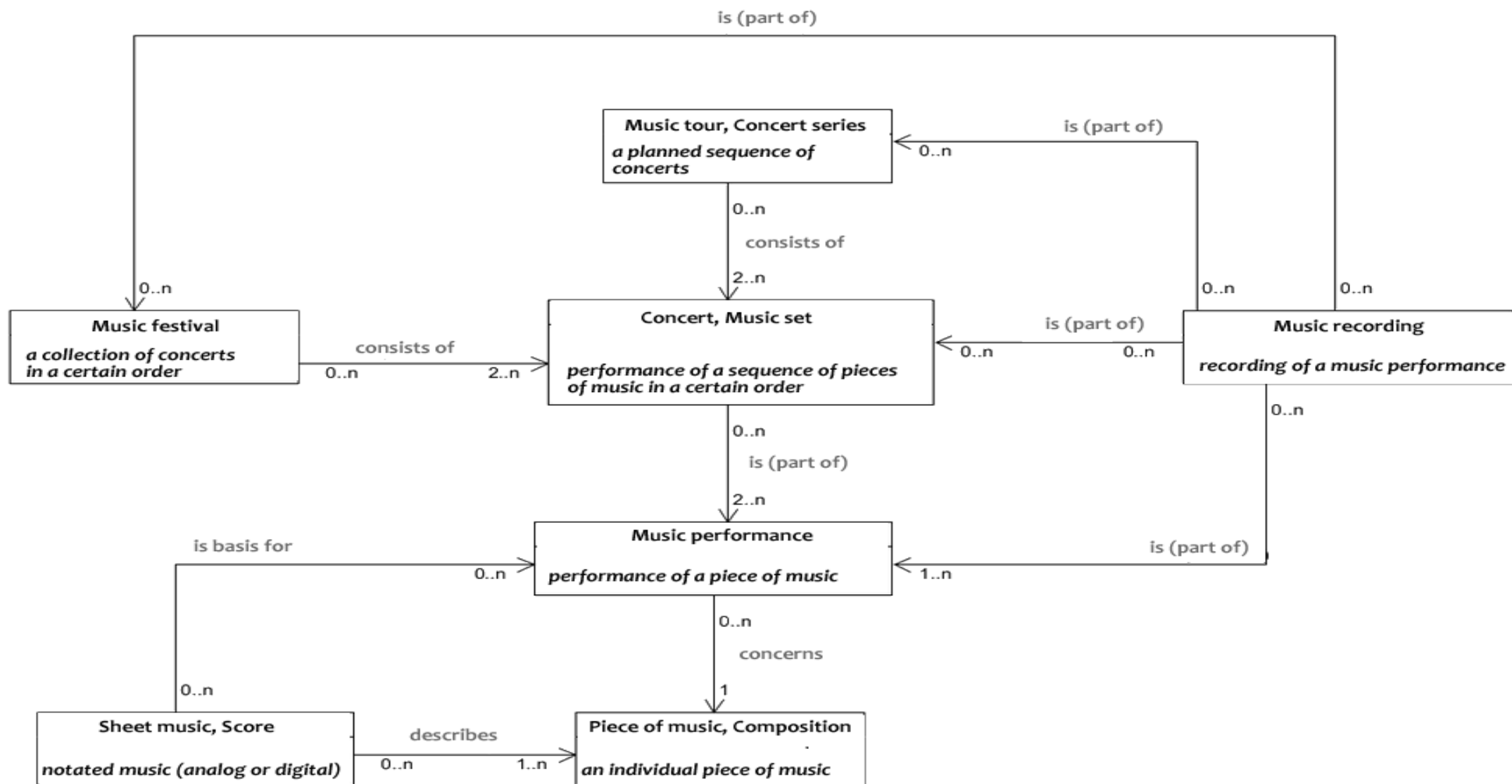
Six core identities:

1. **Work level:**
 - o *Piece*: e.g., play, music, dance.
 - o *Production program*: e.g., concert, dance program.
 - o *Event program*: e.g., festival, radio show.

2. **Expression level:**
 - o *Performance*: a specific execution of a piece.
 - o *Production program performance*: a series of similar performances.
 - o *Event program performance*: a sequence of various performances (e.g., festival edition).

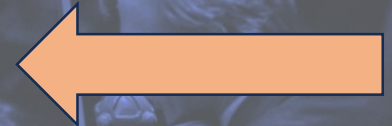
Entities model

Performing Arts Persons

Proof of Concept

Person entities from three datasets: Muziekschatten, Muziekweb and the Common Thesaurus for Audiovisual Archives

Questions:

- Is it possible to create a distributed source using only linked data techniques?
- Can identical or similar name forms from different sources be merged into a single identity?
- Should a single be published in a central source?
- Is it possible to share subject matter expertise?
- Can users of the vocabulary easily select the proper identity?
- Can we find an efficient form of management (with quality/topicality as the most important characteristic)?
- Is it possible to apply the result on other types of datasets? (e.g. corporate bodies, creative works, functions/roles)

Performing Arts Persons

Proof of Concept

Constructing the vocabulary in four steps:

1. extraction of relevant persons from the three datasets
2. normalisation of personal names
3. pre-calculation of relationships
4. constructing a vocabulary

Result: 6.708 clusters of persons from all three sources

Performing Arts Persons

Proof of Concept

Lessons learned:

- Technically it is possible to construct a vocabulary of persons
- Conceptual handling of large amounts of sources and data is challenging
- Quality is more important than quantity
- Just using personal names is not enough

Performing Arts Persons

Management and curation

Five scenarios:

1. **Termennetwerk (Dutch network of terms)**

A linked data service that provides standardized Dutch terminologies and vocabularies for heritage, archives, and museums.

2. **Wikidata**

A free, collaborative, multilingual knowledge base that stores structured data for use across Wikimedia projects and beyond.

3. **Wikibase**

An open-source software platform developed by Wikimedia to create and manage custom structured data repositories.

4. **Omeka S**

A linked data publishing platform for institutions managing digital collections.

5. **Distributed Vocabulary of Persons** *(see earlier)*

Performing Arts Persons

Management and curation

General questions:

- What are the chances of this scenario?
- What are the disadvantages of this scenario?
- Which of the goals of the Proof of Concept will be achieved in this scenario?
- What does it take to make the scenario work?
- Who should/can carry out management and curation?
- Which are the financial consequences?
- Is the scenario easily accessible to users that have hardly any technical knowledge?
- Is the scenario easy to implement in existing collection management systems?

Conclusion:

“At this point there is no single scenario that provides a solution that can be put into practice without further ado.”
